**FINAL ORDER OF REVOCATION**

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (the "Board") on September 12, 2013, at the office of the Board, 101 N.E. 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Scott Randall Sullivan, Special Prosecutor for the Board, appeared for the plaintiff and Defendant appeared not.

The Board *en banc*, being fully advised in the premises, found that there is clear and convincing evidence to support the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

**Findings of Fact**

1. The Board is a duly authorized agency of the State of Oklahoma empowered to license and oversee the activities of physicians and surgeons in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to 59 Okla. Stat. §480 *et seq.* The Board has jurisdiction over this matter, and notice has been given in all respects in accordance with law and the rules of the Board.

2. Defendant, Jennifer Goucher, holds occupational therapy assistant license no. OA1007 and has practiced in Oklahoma.

3. On or about February 28, 2013 Defendant entered a **PLEA OF GUILTY** to **COUNT 1: LARCENEY OF MERCHANDISE FROM RETAILER, a FELONY.**

**Conclusions of Law**

1. The Board has jurisdiction and authority over the Defendant and subject matter herein pursuant to the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act (the "Act") and its applicable regulations. The Board is authorized to enforce the Act as necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

2. Pursuant to *Oklahoma Administrative Code Rule 435:5-1-5.2*:

(b) The Board shall revoke the license of a person licensed by the Board who has a final felony conviction.

3. The Board further found that the Defendant's license should be **REVOKED** based upon *Oklahoma Administrative Code Rule 435:5-1-5.2* as stated above.


**Order**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. The license of Defendant, Jennifer Goucher, occupational therapy assistant license no. OA1007, is hereby **REVOKED** as of the date of this hearing, September 12, 2013.


