ORDER TERMINATING RESTRICTION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on September 18, 2008, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Paul Lopez Rodriguez, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 10166, appeared in person and pro se.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 2. Dr. Rodriguez currently holds **RESTRICTED** medical license no. 10166 whereby he is not allowed to supervise physician assistants. Dr. Rodriguez's license was restricted on November 5, 2004.
- 3. Dr. Rodriguez has requested that his restriction be lifted so as to allow him to seek reinstatement of his Board Certification in General Radiology with the American Board of Radiology
- 4. Dr. Rodriguez has complied to date in all respects with the terms of his restriction, and the purposes of the restriction have been accomplished. Dr. Rodriguez has presented sufficient evidence to support the termination of his restriction.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 et seq.
- 2. Dr. Rodriguez has presented satisfactory evidence to justify termination of the restriction on his license. The purposes of the restriction have been accomplished by Dr. Rodriguez's compliance with the restriction. No useful purpose would be gained by having Dr. Rodriguez continue to practice under a restricted license.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. Dr. Rodriguez's application to terminate his restriction is **GRANTED** and his restriction is terminated effective September 18, 2008.
- 2. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Rodriguez as soon as it is processed.
