COMPLAINT

COMES NOW the plaintiff, the State of Oklahoma ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (the "Board"), by and through its attorney, Elizabeth A. Scott, Assistant Attorney General, and for its Complaint against the Defendant, John Baxter Hamilton, M.D., Oklahoma license no. 10235, alleges and states as follows:

1. The Board is a duly authorized agency of the State of Oklahoma empowered to license and oversee the activities of physicians and surgeons in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to 59 Okla. Stat. §480 *et seq.*
2. Defendant, John Baxter Hamilton, M.D., holds Oklahoma license no. 10235.
3. On or about December 19, 2001, Defendant was convicted of Murder in the First Degree in violation of 21 O.S. §701.7 in Case No. CF-01-1147, in the District Court of Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma. As a result of this conviction, Defendant was sentenced on or about January 8, 2002 to Life Imprisonment Without the Possibility of Parole
4. Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct in that he:


- A. Engaged in dishonorable or immoral conduct which is likely to deceive, defraud or harm the public in violation of 59 O.S. § 509 (9) and OAC 435:10-7-4 (11).
- B. Was convicted of a felony or of any offense involving moral turpitude in violation of 59 O.S. §509(6) and OAC 435:10-7-4(10).
- C. Violated any provision of the medical practice act or the rules and regulations of the Board or of an action, stipulation, or agreement of the Board in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(39) and 59 O.S. §509(14).
- D. Was convicted or confessed to a crime involving violation of the laws of this state in violation of 59 O.S. §509(8).

Conclusion

WHEREFORE, plaintiff requests that the Board conduct a hearing, and upon proof of the allegations contained herein, impose such disciplinary action as authorized by law, up to and including the revocation or suspension of the Defendant's license to practice as a physician and surgeon in the State of Oklahoma, the assessment of costs and fees incurred in this action, and any other appropriate action with respect to Defendant's license to practice as a physician and surgeon in the State of Oklahoma.
