ORDER OF SUSPENSION
AND PAYMENT OF COSTS

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on May 14, 1993, at the office of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Lila V. Nevrekar, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person and by legal counsel, Stan Twardy, Attorney at Law 1400 N. Shartel, Oklahoma City, OK 73103.

The Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision reviewed exhibits, heard statements and being fully advised in the premises, the Oklahoma Board finds and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Lila V. Nevrekar, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 10357.
2. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
3. That on or around January 21, 1993, Defendant, with the advice of legal counsel, voluntarily entered a plea of Guilty to the felony charge of Medicaid Fraud in violation of 56 O.S. 1991, Sec. 1006(B). The Guilty plea was entered in Oklahoma County Case No. CF-93-170, State of Oklahoma v. Lila V. Nevrekar, M.D.
4. That on March 5, 1993, formal sentencing of Defendant was deferred until March 4, 1996, and Defendant was ordered to pay a fine in the amount of \$17,000.00 on or before March 4, 1994.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That Lila V. Nevrekar, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 10357, is in violation of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1991, Sec. 509, Paragraph 10, to-wit:

- "10. The commission of any act which is a violation of the criminal laws of Oklahoma when such act is connected with the physician's practice of medicine. A complaint, indictment or confession of a


criminal violation shall not be necessary for the enforcement of this provision. Proof of the commission of the act while in the practice of medicine or under the guise of the practice of medicine shall be unprofessional conduct."

ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That Defendant, Lila V. Nevrekar, M.D., Oklahoma Medical License No. 10357 should be and is hereby SUSPENDED for a period of three (3) days beginning at 5:25 p.m. on May 14, 1993.
2. That Defendant shall promptly pay within thirty (30) days of receipt of invoice from the Board the costs of investigation, prosecution and probation of this case.
3. That a copy of this written Order should be sent to the Defendant and/or his legal counsel as soon as possible so their record is complete.
