FINAL ORDER

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners en banc on January 13, 1984, at 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the Rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff and D. C. Thomas and Merle Gile, Attorneys, appeared for the Defendant.

The counsel for the parties then advised the Board of Medical Examiners of a proposed disposition of this case. Said proposal is hereby adopted and the Board of Medical Examiners issues the following order:

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Examiners of Oklahoma as follows:

- 1. That the Defendant, Jimmy Charles Martin, M.D., Medical License No. 10534, will be and is hereby placed on probation to the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners for a period of five years, beginning on January 13, 1984, under the following terms and conditions:
 - a. Defendant will immediately surrender his registration for state and federal controlled dangerous substances to the proper authorities and will not apply for state and federal registration for controlled dangerous substances until the term of his probation has expired unless authorized to do so by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners.
 - b Defendant will not prescribe, administer or dispense any scheduled drugs except as set out below.

The Defendant may prescribe scheduled drugs to hospital in-patients when the order is countersigned or co-signed by another physician.

- d. Defendant will submit biological fluid specimens to include, but not limited to, blood and urine, for analysis, upon the request of any inspector or other agent representing the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners.
- e. If a blood test or urine test is flunked because of a showing of drugs or more than a trace of alcohol, the Defendant's Medical License No. 10534 shall be immediately surrendered and revoked by the Board of Medical Examiners with no further notice to Defendant or hearing.

Defendant will comply with the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act as interpreted by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners and that he shall appear before the Board or its representative upon request.

Defendant will furnish to the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners all current legal addresses and any change of address in writing.
