PROPOSED FINAL ORDER

)

This cause came on for consideration before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on July 15, 1995, at the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Gloria Moore, Attorney, appeared for the defendant who was not present, and agreed to proceed.

That the parties presented to the Board a proposed Final Order agreed to by the State and Defendant as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant Nancy Puttroff, P.T., holds Oklahoma Physical Therapy License No. 1069.

2. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

3. That the Defendant Puttroff admits to being the subject of at least an informal guardianship and that her father was appointed as her guardian.

4. That the Defendant Puttroff admits to taking Ativan and other prescription medication, but was unable to advise the Board staff in any detail about her physical or mental condition. 5. That the Defendant Puttroff admits she is presently receiving medical treatment at Park View Place and her present condition is such that she is unable to practice physical therapy. She admits the conduct alleged in the complaint occurred prior to December 31, 1994.

6. That the Defendant Puttroff admits to being in violation of the Oklahoma Physical Therapy Practice Act, 59 9 O.S. 1991, Sec. 887.13, Paragraphs 7,9 and 10.

7. That the defendant waives her right to a hearing on the allegations contained in this Proposed Final Order.

8. That the defendant agrees to a suspension of her license to practice physical therapy for an indefinite period of time.

9. That the defendant understands she has the right to apply for reinstatement of licensure and will be afforded an opportunity to present relevant information regarding her ability to re-enter the practice of physical therapy at the meeting next available after the application for reinstatement is filed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That Nancy Puttroff, P.T., holding Oklahoma Physical Therapy License No 1069 is in violation of the Oklahoma Physical Therapy Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1991, Sec 887.13, Paragraphs 7,9 and 10, to-wit:

- "7. Being grossly negligent in the practice of physical therapy or in acting as a physical therapist assistant."
- "9. Been guilty of conduct unbecoming a person licensed as a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant or guilty of conduct detrimental to the best interest of the public or his profession."
- "10. Been guilty of any act in conflict with the ethics of the profession of physical therapy."

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the license to practice physical therapy held by defendant Nancy Puttroff, P.T., Oklahoma Physical Therapy License No. 1069 should be and is hereby suspended.
