FINAL ORDER REINSTATING PHYSICAL THERAPIST LICENSURE UNDER TERMS OF PROBATION

ON THE 9thday of January, 1997; this cause comes on before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (Board), upon the request of Nancy Puttroff (Applicant), pursuant to notice given as required by law and enumerated at 75 O.S. 1995 Supp., Section 309.

Applicant appeared in person.

The Board heard testimony, reviewed exhibits and being fully advised in the premises, finds and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. That the Applicant is applying for reinstatement of her license to practice physical therapy in Oklahoma.
- 2. That the Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. That following notice and hearing on July 15, 1995, Applicant's Oklahoma Physical Therapy License Number 1069 was suspended.

- 4. Applicant has submitted an application for reinstatement of licensure.
- 5. That the Applicant's license should be reinstated under the terms and conditions set forth hereunder.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter by virtue of the provisions of the Physical Therapy Practice Act, 59 O.S., Sections 887.1 et seq.

<u>ORDER</u>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision that the Oklahoma Physical Therapy License of Nancy Puttroff, Number PT1069, shall be reinstated with one year probation under the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

- 1. During the period of probation, Ms. Puttroff will engage in part-time practice for at least six (6) months followed by full-time practice for at least three (3) months under the direct, on-site supervision of a licensed physical therapist.
- 2. The supervising physical therapist shall submit monthly reports to the Board. If the reports are satisfactory, reporting may be reduced to every two (2) months.
- 3. During the period of probation, Ms. Puttroff's treating physician and counselor shall submit reports to the Board every two (2) months verifying compliance with treatment and medication regimen.
- 4. During the period of probation, Ms. Puttroff shall obtain one (1) continuing education unit with one (1) continuing education unit being equal to ten (10) contact hours of continuing education.
- 5. During the period of probation, Ms. Puttroff will not supervise any physical therapist assistant or student.
- 6. Ms. Puttroff will appear before the Physical Therapy Advisory Committee after six (6) months for re-evaluation. The Committee's recommendation as to future appearances before the Committee, evaluations or extensions of probation will be forwarded to the Board for review.

- 7. The jurisdiction of the Board in this individual proceeding will continue until the terms and conditions of probation are modified or lifted by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on their own motion or on the motion of Ms. Puttroff.
- 8. During the period of probation, Ms. Puttroff will keep current payment of all assessment by the Board for prosecution, investigation and monitoring of her case.
