

the Defendant's voluntary resignation from practice in Oklahoma and resignation of license with the express provision that the Defendant may not re-apply for licensure as a physician and surgeon in the State of Oklahoma.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the Board has jurisdiction over the Defendant pursuant to the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1989, Sec. 481 et seq.

2. That the decision to accept resignation of license by a physician while a disciplinary matter is pending is within the discretion and judgment of the Board.

ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the resignation of licensure tendered by the Defendant, William H. Philpott, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 10713, should be and the same is hereby ACCEPTED.


2. That the resignation of the Defendant is accepted with the specific provision that the Defendant may not re-apply for licensure as a physician and surgeon in the State of Oklahoma.
