FINAL ORDER

The counsel for the parties then advised the Board of Medical Examiners of a proposed disposition of this case. Said proposal is hereby adopted and the Board of Medical Examiners issues the following Order:

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical examiners of Oklahoma as follows:

- 1. That the Defendant, V.G. Bhopale, M.D., License No. 10822, be and is hereby suspended for a period of 45 days beginning on June 1, 1984.
- 2. That at the end of the suspension period the Defendant will be and is hereby placed on a period of probation of five years under the following terms and conditions:
 - a. That Defendant shall not administer, prescribe or dispense Schedule II drugs to any patient, except for hospital in-patients.
 - b. That Defendant shall maintain duplicate, serially-numbered prescriptions for all Schedule III, IV, and V drugs prescribed and shall make said records available for inspection to any agent of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners upon request.
 - c. During the period of probation Defendant will furnish to the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners all current legal addresses and any change in address in writing.
