ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc on the 14th day of May, 1988, at the office of the Oklahoma State Medical Association, 601 NW Expressway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff, and Stanley Eugene Pollman, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person, pro se.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard the testimony and reviewed exhibits and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Stanley Eugene Pollman, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 10841.
2. That the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
3. That evidence showed that the states of Missouri and Kansas had advised the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision that the Defendant had successfully completed probation in those respective states. That the Defendant had fulfilled terms and conditions of probation since it was imposed by this Board.
4. That there was no longer any reason for probation to protect public health, safety and welfare of the Oklahoma public.
5. That the Board wanted to express on the record appreciation to the Defendant for his cooperation and successful completion of probation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has lawful jurisdiction over this Defendant pursuant to the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1987, Section 481 et seq.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the Defendant, Stanley Eugene Pollman, M.D., Oklahoma Medical License No. 10841, should be and is hereby released from the terms and conditions of probation imposed by this Board following hearing on April 30, 1987, and that said Final Order should be and the same is hereby held for naught.


2. That this Order Terminating Probation should be made a part of the public record of the Defendant, and that Defendant should be formally advised of same.
