## COMPLAINT

COMES NOW Phillip W. McPherren, Inspector for the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners, being first duly sworn upon oath and states:

- 1. That William Patrick Mappes, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 10934, is in violation of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1981, §509, Paragraphs 5 and 8, to-wit:
  - "5. Habitual intemperance or the habitual use of habit-forming drugs."
  - "8. . . . confession of a crime involving the violation of the anti-narcotic or prohibition laws and regulations of the federal government or the Board of Health laws and regulations of the State of Oklahoma."
- 2. That William Patrick Mappes, M.D., is in violation of the Rules and Regulations promulgated by this Board, specifically Section IX, Rules 3 and 5, to-wit
  - "Rule 3: The habitual or excessive use of any drug which impairs the ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to the patient."
  - "Rule 5: Purchasing or prescribing any regulated substance in Schedules I through V, as defined by the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act, for the physician's personal use."
- 3. That from the fall of 1983 to April, 1984, Defendant, William Patrick Mappes, did personally obtain and use cocaine on a regular, weekly basis. That said cocaine is a habit-forming drug and is a scheduled and regulated substance as defined by the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act

4. That Defendant's aforesaid personal use of cocaine was admitted in open court, under oath, in testimony before United States District Judge Ralph Thompson in August, 1984, and said testimony constitutes confession of a crime involving the violation of anti-narcotic laws of the federal government and the State of Oklahoma.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays this Board to conduct a hearing upon proof of the allegations contained herein that such disciplinary action be taken by the Board as is authorized by
