FINAL ORDER

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners en banc on September 21, 1984, at 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the Rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff, and David Kline, attorney, appeared for the Defendant.

The counsel for the parties then advised the Board of Medical Examiners of a proposed disposition of this case. Said proposal is hereby adopted and the Board of Medical Examiners being fully advised in the premises therefor finds and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That William Patrick Mappes, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 10934.

2. That the Board of Medical Examiners en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the Rules of the Board.

3. That the facts set forth in the Complaint served on the Defendant are true and correct.

4. That the Defendant, under the advice of competent counsel, and in lieu of a full hearing on the issues set forth in the Complaint, did hereby voluntarily surrender his Oklahoma medical license.

5. In the event that the Defendant's circumstances change in the future that the Defendant may re-apply for his Oklahoma medical license and that the Board specifically retains continuing jurisdiction to review the applicant at that time as to his professional and clinical competence.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Examiners of Oklahoma as follows:

1. That the Defendant's voluntary surrender of his Oklahoma Medical License No. 10934 in lieu of a hearing on the Complaint served herein is hereby accepted.

2. That the Board specifically retains continuing jurisdiction over the Defendant and the Defendant may re-apply for the aforesaid Oklahoma medical license when his personal circumstances change. At the time of the Defendant's re-application the Board may inquire into the Defendant's professional and clinical competence.


