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## COMPLAINT

COMES NOW Mike Kiser, Director of Investigation for the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, being first duly sworn upon oath and states:

- 1. That Virgilio T. Guzman, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 10982, is in violation of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1991, Sec. 509, Paragraph 9, to-wit:
  - "9. Dishonorable or immoral conduct which is likely to deceive or defraud the public."
- 2. That on or around May 7, 1992, the Department of Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois approved a Consent Order in Case No. 90-1381 wherein the Defendant stipulated that the Department of Professional Regulation had evidence that Defendant may have failed to properly monitor the post-operative recovery of a patient and although he was the supervising anesthesiologist, left the hospital premises. In the Consent Order Defendant agreed to a probation of three (3) years under terms and conditions that include requirement for 50 additional hours of continuing medical education each year above and beyond the continuing education already required by Illinois law.
- 3. That Defendant is perpetuating significant harm to public health, safety and welfare by the acts and omissions set forth in the above allegations.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays this Board to conduct a hearing and upon proof of the allegations contained herein that such disciplinary action be taken by the Board as is authorized by law.
