ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on November 21, 2002, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Rajendra Amin, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 11099, appeared in person and pro se.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

2. Dr. Amin currently holds medical license no. 11099 under a five (5) year term of probation that commenced on or around September 16, 1999.

3. Dr. Amin has requested that his probation be terminated effective November 21, 2002 so as to allow him to obtain hospital privileges and to seek contracts with insurance companies.

4. Tom Sosbee, Compliance and Education Coordinator for the Board, testified that the Board staff did not support the requested early termination.

5. Dr. Amin has presented sufficient evidence to support the requested early termination.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 *et seq.*
2. Dr. Amin has presented satisfactory evidence to justify termination of the remainder of his probationary period. The purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished. No useful purpose would be gained by having Dr. Amin serve the remainder of his probationary term.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. Dr. Amin's application to terminate probation is **GRANTED** and his probationary period is terminated effective November 21, 2002.
2. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Amin as soon as it is processed.
