ORDER TO STAY HEARING

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on May 14, 1993, at the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Bert M. Avery, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person and by legal counsel, Robert L. Wyatt, IV, of Jones & Wyatt, Attorneys, 114 E. Broadway, Suite 1100, P.O. Box 472, Enid, OK 73702-0472.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc reviewed exhibits, heard statements and being fully advised in the premises, the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision finds and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. That Defendant, Bert M. Avery, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 11216.
- 2. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. That Defendant presented Motion to File Errata Sheet, Motion to File Out of Time, and Motion to Dismiss Complaint. Board staff had no objection to the Motion to File Errata Sheet and Motion to File Out of Time. The Defendant's Motion to Dismiss was sustained in part, and Plaintiff was ordered to strike from the Complaint any reference to Sec. 509, Para. 10.
- 4. That Defendant's Alternative Motion to Stay Proceedings was granted on the basis that Defendant was not yet convicted as a matter of law.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Until Judgment and Sentence is entered against Defendant, Bert M. Avery, in <u>United States v. Avery</u>, CR-92-106-R, pending in the United States District Court for the Western District of Oklahoma, or some other case, Defendant has not been "convicted" as a matter of law, see <u>State v. Bridwell</u>, 592 P.2d 520 (Okl. 1979).

ORDER

- IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:
- 1. That Defendant's Motion to File Errata Sheet and Motion to File Out of Time should be and are hereby SUSTAINED.
- 2. That Defendant's Motion to Dismiss Complaint is SUSTAINED IN PART and Plaintiff is ordered to strike from the Complaint any reference to 59 O.S. 1991, Sec. 509, Para. 10.
- That Defendant's Alternative Motion to Stay Proceedings should be and is hereby GRANTED.
- 4. That a copy of this written Order should be sent to the Defendant and/or his legal counsel as soon as possible so their record is complete.
