ORDER REINSTATING LICENSE AND GRANTING PHYSICIAN EMERITUS STATUS

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on July 18, 2002, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Charles McCall, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 11275, appeared not.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 2. At the June 28, 2002 Board meeting, Applicant requested that his license be reinstated, at which time the Board tabled his request so as to allow him to take the SPEX examination.
- 3. Applicant subsequently requested that his license be reinstated, and that it immediately be placed on Physician Emeritus status.
- 4. Board staff does not oppose Applicant's request for reinstatement so long as he is immediately placed on Physician Emeritus status.
- 6. Applicant has submitted satisfactory evidence to support his request for reinstatement and for Physician Emeritus status.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 et seq.
- 2. Applicant has submitted satisfactory evidence to support his request for reinstatement and for Physician Emeritus status.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. Applicant's request for reinstatement of his Oklahoma medical license is GRANTED.
- 2. Applicant's license shall immediately be placed on Physician Emeritus status, whereby he shall not be allowed to practice medicine in any form, prescribe, dispense or administer drugs pursuant to OAC 435:10-7-6.
 - 3. A copy of this written order should be sent to Applicant as soon as it is processed.
