ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on September 21, 2006, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Jonathan Drake Chancellor, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 11284, appeared in person and pro se.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- Dr. Chancellor currently holds medical license no. 11284 under a five (5) year term of probation that commenced on or around October 22, 2005.
- 3. Dr. Chancellor has requested that his probation be terminated effective September 21, 2006 since he has satisfied all requirements of his probation.
- 4. Tom Sosbee, Compliance and Education Coordinator for the Board, testified that the Board staff has no objection to the requested termination.
- 5. Dr. Chancellor has presented sufficient evidence to support the requested early termination.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 et seq.
- 2. Dr. Chancellor has presented satisfactory evidence to justify termination of the remainder of his probationary period. The purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished. No useful purpose would be gained by having Dr. Chancellor serve the remainder of his probationary term.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. Dr. Chancellor's application to terminate probation is **GRANTED** and his probationary period is terminated effective September 21, 2006.
- 2. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Chancellor as soon as it is processed.
