**AGREED FINAL ORDER
GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE
AND IMPOSING PROBATION AND MONITORING**

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (the "Board") on May 28, 1998, at the Board offices, 5104 North Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Stanley S. Hanan ("Applicant") appeared in person and with his attorney, Tom Morris. Susan Moebius Henderson, Assistant Attorney General for the State of Oklahoma, appeared as attorney on behalf of the Board.

After hearing testimony, reviewing the materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, the Board made the following findings of fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Applicant previously held Oklahoma Medical License Number 11542, which he failed to renew following an official reprimand in January 1997 for unprofessional conduct. At that time Applicant and the Board entered into an Agreed Order of Reprimand with Stipulations which required probation and monitoring if and when Applicant ever attempted to renew his Oklahoma medical license (the "1997 Order").

2. Applicant now seeks reinstatement of his license in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon and has agreed to the terms and conditions of probation as set forth more fully below

3. Applicant, by signing below, acknowledges and agrees that (i) he is of sound mind and is not under the influence of, or impaired by, any medication or drug, (ii) he has read and understands the terms of this order; and (iii) he has agreed to and signed this order voluntarily.

4. The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and proper notice has been given to Applicant pursuant to 59 Okla. Stat. § 480 *et seq.*

2. This order shall be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank and to the Federation of Medical Licensing Boards as continuation of the disciplinary action evidenced by the 1997 Order.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board that Applicant's license, Oklahoma medical license number 11542, is hereby reinstated and that Applicant may practice as a physician and surgeon under the following terms and conditions:

As a condition of reinstatement, Applicant will be placed upon probation for a period of five (5) years, with the following terms and conditions of probation:


1. Applicant will keep duplicate, serially numbered prescriptions of all controlled dangerous substances and addictive drugs readily retrievable, in numerical order and will furnish copies to investigators or other authorized agents of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision immediately upon request.

2. Applicant will practice in a controlled environment approved by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision or its designee.

3. Applicant will conduct his practice in compliance with the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act as interpreted by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. Any question of interpretation regarding said Act shall be submitted in writing to the Board and no action based on the subject of the question will be taken by Applicant until clarification of interpretation is received by Applicant from the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.


4. Applicant will request the Kanza medical facility, and any other approved hospital, medical facility or clinic in which he lawfully practices to furnish to the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision upon request a written statement regarding his practice while performing services there.
5. Applicant will furnish to each and every state or sovereign nation in which he holds licensure or applies for licensure and any hospitals, clinics or other institutions in which he holds or anticipates holding any form of staff privilege or employment, a copy of the 1997 Order and this Order stipulating sanctions imposed by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.
6. Applicant will not supervise allied health professionals.
7. Applicant will not prescribe, administer or dispense any medications for personal use or for use by his family members.
8. Applicant will keep the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision informed of his current practice address.
9. Applicant will keep current payment of all assessment by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision for prosecution, investigation and monitoring of his case.
10. Until such time as all indebtedness to the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision has been satisfied, Applicant will reaffirm said indebtedness in any and all bankruptcy proceedings.
11. Applicant will generate and maintain complete, accurate medical records and will furnish to the Board, its investigators or representatives, information lawfully requested by the Board. It shall be Applicant's responsibility to assure the cooperation of The Kanza medical facility in complying with requests for information about Applicant's practice at The Kanza medical facility.
12. Applicant will cooperate fully in any investigation of his practice conducted by the Board.
13. Applicant will present himself for a personal appearance upon the request of the Board.
