CORRECTED
ORDER RESTORING FULL LICENSURE

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on May 14, 1993, at the office of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Larry D. Ottaway and Timothy M. Melton, Attorneys, of Foliart, Huff, Ottaway & Caldwell, 120 N. Robinson, 20th Floor, Oklahoma City, OK 73102, appeared for the Defendant, and Defendant appeared in person.

The Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision heard argument and statements, reviewed exhibits and being fully advised in the premises, the Oklahoma Board finds and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Paul P. Devaneson, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 11656.

2. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

3. That the Defendant's actions on or around February 13, 1985, while in the United States Air Force at Sheppard Air Force Base, Texas, were investigated through the office of the Hospital Commander. That on or around July 9, 1985, the Staff Judge Advocate recommended that charges made by the Hospital Commander be tried by General Court Martial. That on or around October 23, 1985, a General Court Martial was convened at Sheppard Air Force Base, Texas, and the Defendant was tried on certain offenses and found guilty thereon. That the Defendant's conviction was timely appealed to the United States Air Force Court of Military Review and the appeal on the aforesaid charges was affirmed by written decision dated June 25, 1986. On December 17, 1987, the Court Martial was affirmed by order of the Secretary of the Air Force and the Defendant received notice thereof on or around December 31, 1987.

4. Defendant continues to reside and practice in the State of Texas and the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners has investigated this information and closed its investigation without taking any action, due to lack of evidence.

5. There was no investigation by the Board and no evidence submitted since the original hearing in May, 1988, as to any question as to Defendant's present and current fitness to practice medicine and surgery. There is no further reason that Defendant should again appear before the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, or its designee, for an interview as to his fitness for practice and qualifications.

6. That the reprimand of record received by Defendant following notice and hearing of May 13, 1988, remains on the record.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision has lawful jurisdiction over this Defendant pursuant to the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1991, Sec. 481 et seq.

ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the Defendant, Paul P. Devaneson, M.D., Oklahoma Medical License No. 11656, should and does hereby receive a full, unfettered Oklahoma Medical License.


2. That there is no further requirement that Defendant appear before the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, or its designee, for any interview as to his fitness for practice or qualifications.


3. That a copy of this written Order should be sent to the Defendant and/or his legal counsel as soon as possible so their record is complete.
