COMPLAINT

COMES NOW CAROLE A. SMITH, Inspector for the State Board of Medical Examiners, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, being first duly sworn upon oath, and states as follows:

That Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No.
11760, is charged with unprofessional conduct, to wit: Violation of the Oklahoma
Medical Practice Act, Title 59 O.S. Supp., 1980, Section 509, paragraph 16, to wit:

"16. The inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of age, illness, drunkeness, excessive use of drugs, narcotics, chemicals, or any other type of material or as a result of any mental or physical condition."

2. That evidence gathered during my investigation indicates that from March, 1980, to date, Dr. Thomas has been an impaired physician and has been unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients, due to a physical condition which may be the result of seizures or drug abuse.

3. That pursuant to paragraph 16 of the Medical Practice Act, this Board should conduct a hearing to determine the extent of impairment and determine the appropriate action to be taken.

4. That Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D., is presently on probation status as reflected by the order issued by this Board dated September 22, 1979.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Complainant prays that this Board hold a hearing to determine the nature and extent of impairment and take such action as is authorized by law.
