## ORDER

NOW on this 23rd day of January, 1981, the above styled cause comes on for hearing before the State Board of Medical Examiners. The plaintiff was represented by its attorney, Kay Karen Kennedy; the defendant appeared in person and with her attorneys, Cal Hendrickson and Jan Pope.

After careful consideration of all testimony presented and a review of the medical records offered into evidence, the Board entered into deliberation to determine if the defendant was impaired as defined in the Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 509,paragraph 16. The deliberation and motions of the Board are incorporated herein by reference

Based on the findings of the Board, the following Orders were entered: Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D., is an impaired physician, as defined by paragraph 16 of section 509 of the Medical Practice Act, Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

That Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D., be placed on a five year probation with the following terms and conditions:

That Dr. Thomas abstains from any self-medicating;

2. That Dr. Thomas designate Dr. Peggy Wisdom as her personal, attending physician; that before taking any medication, whether or not prescribed by another physician, Dr. Wisdom be notified of the drugs to be taken;

3. That Dr. Thomas submit blood and urine specimens for analysis when requested to do so by Inspectors from the Board of Medical Examiners;

4. That Dr. Thomas authorize Dr. Ellis to notify the Board of any aberrant behavior and to notify Dr. Wisdom in order to obtain an EEG;

5. That Dr. Thomas is to abstain from the use of alcohol unless said alcohol is authorized by Dr. Wisdom;

6. That Dr. Thomas authorize Dr. Wisdom and Dr.Ellis, and any other physician who undertakes care or treatment of Dr. Thomas, to submit reports

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on the medical status of Dr. Thomas;

7. Failure to comply with the terms of this probation will result

in a citation being issued;

8. That Dr. Thomas shall appear before the Board when requested to do so.
