C O M P L A I N T

COMES NOW CAROLE A. SMITH, Inspector for the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners, first being duly sworn upon her oath, and states:

1. That Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 11760, is charged with unprofessional conduct, to-wit: Violation of The Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, Title 59 O.S. 1980 Supp., Section 509, paragraphs 5, 10, 12, 14, and 16 to-wit:

"5. Habitual intemperance or the habitual use of habit-forming drugs."

"10. The commission of any act which is a violation of the criminal laws of Oklahoma when such act is connected with the physician's practice of medicine. A complaint, indictment or confession of a criminal violation shall not be necessary for the enforcement of this provision. Proof of the commission of the act while in the practice of medicine or under the guise of the practice of medicine shall be unprofessional conduct."

"12. The writing of false or fictitious prescriptions for any drugs or narcotics declared by the laws of Oklahoma to be controlled or narcotic drugs."

"14. The violation, or attempted violation, direct or indirect, of any of the provisions of this act, either as a principal, accessory or accomplice."

"16. The inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of age, illness, drunkenness, excessive use of drugs, narcotics, chemicals, or any other type of material or as a result of any mental or physical condition."

2. That Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D. is in violation of Rule 5 IX of the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the Board, to-wit:

"Rule 5. Purchasing or prescribing any regulated substance in Schedules I through V, as defined by the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, for the physician's personal use."

3. That Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D. is in violation of this Board's Order dated January 23, 1981, to-wit:

"1 That Dr. Thomas abstain from any self-medicating;"

"5. That Dr. Thomas is to abstain from the use of alcohol unless said alcohol is authorized by Dr. Wisdom;"

4. That on the 29th day of November, 1981, Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D. personally presented a prescription for Fiorinal #3, 30 dosage units, in the name of Mary Howard.

5. That based upon information obtained by this Complainant, there is reason to believe that the doctor was attempting to obtain the drug for her personal use.

6. That said prescription constituted a false and fictitious prescription used to obtain a scheduled drug, in violation of 63 O.S. 1971, § 2-406.

7. That Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D., in violation of this Board's Order dated January 23, 1981, failed to abstain from the use of alcohol as reflected in a blood alcohol analysis made on October 30, 1981.

8. That Georgia Anne Thomas, M.D. is presently unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients as a result of her mental condition.

9. That the Medical License of George Anne Thomas, M.D., Medical License No. 11760, is on probation as reflected by this Board's Order dated January 23, 1981.

WHEREFORE, upon proof of the matters herein alleged, Complainant prays this Board to take such disciplinary action as may be deemed appropriate.
