CONSENT ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Secretary of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (hereafter the "Board") on this ~~14th~~ day of August, 1997, with the written consent of the President of the Board that a hearing be held on the State's Application for Emergency Hearing on Immediate, Temporary Suspension. The State appears by and through its attorney, Gregory Ryan. The defendant appears in person and by his attorneys, Richard B. Talley and Edward T. Tillery.


The Secretary has received evidence from the State and from the defendant. The Secretary has further heard the argument of counsel. Prior to rendition of a decision on the State's Application for Emergency Hearing on Immediate, Temporary Suspension, the defendant has agreed to enter into this Consent Order. The Secretary finds that the defendant has voluntarily submitted to the jurisdiction of this Board and that the Board does have jurisdiction to enter this Consent Order. The Secretary approves this Consent Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


1. The Board has jurisdiction over the defendant and the subject-matter of this action.
2. The defendant shall not consult with, examine, treat or in any other way come in contact with a female patient, in a doctor/patient relationship, without the on-site presence of another licensed healthcare professional.
3. The aforementioned monitoring by a licensed healthcare professional is a mandatory condition to the defendant's continued practice of medicine pending final outcome of this case on the merits.
4. This Consent Order shall be reported by the Board to the National Practitioner's Data Bank.
5. Any violation of this Consent Order shall be grounds for immediate suspension upon further hearing before the Secretary.
6. Upon entry of this Consent Order, the State's Application for Emergency Hearing on Immediate, Temporary Suspension is rendered moot.
7. This Order shall remain in full force and effect, pending hearing on the merits of the Complaint before the Board.
