

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 *et seq.*
2. Dr. Solano has presented satisfactory evidence to justify allowing him to utilize Shelley Lee Wills, an unlicensed health care provider, to act as his chaperone when he is examining or performing services on female patients. Dr. Solano has also presented satisfactory evidence to justify deleting the requirement in his probation that he be required to comply with the Impaired Physician Contract with Hillcrest Medical Center since he is no longer employed by Hillcrest Medical Center.


ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

Dr. Solano's application to modify the terms of his probation is **GRANTED**.

2. Dr. Solano's probation shall continue from May 29, 2003 for a period of five (5) years under the terms and conditions set forth in the May 29, 2003 Order, with the exception that Dr. Solano be allowed to utilize Shelley Lee Wills, an unlicensed health care provider, to act as his chaperone when he is examining or performing services on female patients, and that he is no longer required to comply with the Impaired Physician Contract with Hillcrest Medical Center since he is no longer employed by Hillcrest Medical Center.
3. Failure to meet any of the terms of this Order will be grounds for the Board to initiate proceedings to suspend or revoke Dr. Solano's medical license, after additional notice and hearing as required by law.
4. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Solano as soon as it is processed.


