

4. On May 5, 2005, Dr. Solano requested that the terms of his probation be modified to allow him to continue his treatment with his therapist and his psychiatrist every other week, rather than every week as is currently required under his May 29, 2003 Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction.

5. Dr. Solano presented sufficient evidence to support the requested modifications.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 *et seq.*

2. Dr. Solano has presented satisfactory evidence to justify allowing him to continue his treatment with his therapist and his psychiatrist every other week, rather than every week as is currently required under his May 29, 2003 Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:


1. Dr. Solano's application to modify the terms of his probation is **GRANTED**.

2. Dr. Solano's probation shall continue from May 29, 2003 for a period of five (5) years under the terms and conditions set forth in the May 29, 2003 Order and the January 27, 2005 Order Modifying Probation, with the exception that Dr. Solano be allowed to continue his treatment with his therapist and his psychiatrist every other week, rather than every week as is currently required under his May 29, 2003 Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction.

3. Failure to meet any of the terms of this Order will be grounds for the Board to initiate proceedings to suspend or revoke Dr. Solano's medical license, after additional notice and hearing as required by law.

4. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Solano as soon as it is processed.


