



serially numbered prescriptions. Dr. Robberson also requested that his therapist submit reports to the Board Secretary twice a year, rather than on a quarterly basis.

5. Dr. Robberson presented sufficient evidence to support the requested modification.

### ***CONCLUSIONS OF LAW***

1 The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 *et seq.*

2. Dr. Robberson has presented satisfactory evidence to justify allowing him to prescribe Schedule II through V controlled dangerous substances to nursing home patients, and to prescribe non-narcotic Schedule II, and both narcotic and non-narcotic Schedule III through V controlled dangerous substances to outpatients on duplicate, serially numbered prescriptions. Dr. Robberson also presented satisfactory evidence to justify allowing his therapist to submit reports to the Board Secretary twice a year, rather than on a quarterly basis.

### ***ORDER***

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:


1 Dr. Robberson's application to modify the terms of his probation is **GRANTED**.

2. Dr. Robberson's probation shall continue indefinitely from the date of its commencement of November 3, 1999 under the terms and conditions set forth in the February 3, 2000 Order and the March 28, 2001 Order Modifying Probation, with the exception that Dr. Robberson be allowed to prescribe Schedule II through V controlled dangerous substances to nursing home patients, and to prescribe non-narcotic Schedule II, and both narcotic and non-narcotic Schedule III through V controlled dangerous substances to outpatients on duplicate, serially numbered prescriptions. Dr. Robberson shall also be allowed to submit reports from his therapist to the Board Secretary twice a year, rather than on a quarterly basis.

3. Failure to meet any of the terms of this Order will be grounds for the Board to initiate proceedings to suspend or revoke Dr. Robberson's medical license, after additional notice and hearing as required by law.


