# FINAL ORDER OF REVOCATION

On the 19<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1997, this cause came on before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision pursuant to notice given as required by laws and rules of the state governing Individual Proceedings.

Plaintiff was represented by Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney at Law. Defendant appeared in person and by legal counsel, Gary Snow, Attorney at Law, Seminole, Oklahoma.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision heard statements of counsel, considered evidence submitted and heard testimony given and being fully advised in the premises, the Board FINDS and ORDERS as follows:

# FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant Larry L. Broadie, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 12218.

- 2. That the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by the law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. Defendant's privileges to practice medicine at Tinker Air Force Base were revoked on December 20, 1995. An Adverse Action Report, filed with the National Practitioner Data Bank on June 18, 1996, states that Defendant's clinical privileges were revoked "due to multiple episodes of failure (sic) take an adequate history and failure to perform an adequate physical exam."
- 4. Defendant signed on June 21, 1996, an Application for Renewal of Oklahoma Medical License on which he indicated that he had <u>not</u> been reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank and that he had <u>not</u> "been denied privileges, lost privileges or received discipline by any hospital or other professional medical organization."
- 5. Defendant's failure to report his loss of privileges and the reasons underlying his revocation is deceitful and fraudulent in violation of 59 O.S. Supp. 1994, Sec. 509(9), and Oklahoma Administrative Code 435:10-7-4 (8), (18), and (32).

#### CONCLUSION OF LAW

- 1. That the Board has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1996, Sec. 481 et seq., and by rules and regulations promulgated by this Board.
- 2. The Defendant has engaged in unprofessional conduct in violation of 59 O.S. Supp. 1994, Sec. 509(9), together with Oklahoma Administrative Code 435:10-7-4 (8), (18), and (32), to-wit:

#### <u>509(9)</u>:

"Dishonorable or immoral conduct which is likely to deceive or defraud the public."

#### 435:10-7-4(8):

"Fraud or misrepresentation in applying for or procuring a medical license or in connection with applying for or procuring periodic re-registration of a medical license."

# 435:10-7-4(18):

"Practice or other behavior that demonstrates an incapacity or incompetence to practice medicine and surgery."

# 435:10-7-4(32):

"Failure to report to the Board any adverse action taken against him or her by another licensing jurisdiction (United States or foreign), by any governmental agency, by any law enforcement agency, or by any court for acts or conduct similar to acts or conduct that would constitute grounds for action as defined in this section."

# <u>ORDER</u>

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. That Oklahoma Medical License No. 12218 of Larry L. Broadie, M.D., should be and is hereby REVOKED.
- 2. That a copy of this written Order should be sent to the Defendant and/or his legal counsel as soon as possible so their record is complete.
