## ORDER

NOW on this 21st day of May, 1983, comes on for voluntary appearance the Defendant in the above-captioned case. The Plaintiff was represented by its counsel, Daniel J. Gamino. The Defendant was present in person and proceeded pro se. The Board, after careful consideration of testimony of all the witnesses, entered the following order:

IT IS THEREFORE THE ORDER OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA that the five year probation imposed on the Defendant on May 15, 1982, remain in full force and effect and all terms and provisions therein still be fully applicable except that the Defendant shall be allowed to write prescriptions for controlled substances of Schedules II, III, IV and V in a hospital only, and not in any other setting, and that the Defendant shall be permitted to re-apply upon his own initiative to the Drug Enforcement Authority and the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other conditions of probation remain in full force and effect, including the term of probation
