FINAL ORDER ENDING PROBATION ON CERTAIN CONDITIONS

CASE NO. 86-11-453

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc on the 22nd day of January, 1988, at the office of the Oklahoma State Medical Association, 601 NW Expressway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff, and Gary Paul Kula, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person, pro se for the Defendant.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard the testimony and reviewed exhibits and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Gary Paul Kula, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 12616.

2. That the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

3. That Defendant had fulfilled to date all terms and conditions of probation previously imposed by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision and the Defendant's request for termination of probation was not objected to by the Board staff, except that the Defendant had not yet completed one (1) year of probation and that no unusual circumstances existed to terminate the probation until the Defendant had completed one (1) year.

4. That the Defendant's probation was imposed on May 2, 1987, and one (1) year of same would be completed on May 2, 1988.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has inherent power to modify or shorten the term and the period of probation of any Defendant under Board jurisdiction, 59 O.S. Supp. 1987, §506 et seq.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That probation imposed on the Defendant herein on May 2, 1987, should be and the same will end, terminate and be

held for naught on May 2, 1988, on the condition that there be no evidence of the Defendant's violation of any of the terms and conditions of probation up to that date.

2. That the Defendant is advised that representatives of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervison will contact him in the future on normal post-probation visits in order to determine the Defendant's progress and status.
