
SECOND ORDER OF CONTINUANCE

The undersigned Secretary for the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, in consideration of the parties' joint request for a continuance, enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. Defendant has entered into an Agreement Not to Practice in Oklahoma. Defendant currently practices in Texas and has no practice or employment in Oklahoma.
2. The case has been continued once in March of 2013.
3. The parties are hopeful that a Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction ("VSJ") can be negotiated. However, the parties intend to await the results of a Texas investigation and potential case until such time as any Texas matter is resolved.
4. Board staff has no objection to said continuance.
5. For good cause shown, the parties' joint request for a continuance is hereby granted and Defendant's hearing is rescheduled before the Oklahoma State Board of


Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc at its next regularly scheduled meeting on July 11, 2013.
