COMPLAINT

COMES NOW J.G. Landreth, Investigator for the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, being first duly sworn upon oath and states:

That Brent L Wauters, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 12751, is in violation of unprofessional conduct within the definition of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1981, Sec. 509, by the deliberate physican abuse of patients and by an unnecessary confrontational method in dealing with patients

- 2. That on or around August 1, 1987, Defendant was on duty in the Emergency Room at South Community Hospital, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, when he struck in the face a minor female patient, D.Q., who at the time was laying on the examination table restrained under a five point restraint.
- 3. That the Defendant has maintained a pattern and practice of conduct that includes physical violence toward other persons and an unnecessary confrontational method in dealing with patients, specifically including, but not limited to, patients T.H. and L.H.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays this Board to conduct a hearing and upon proof of the allegations contained herein that such
