## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


The Oklahoma State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners has jurisdiction in this matter by virtue of the provisions of the Podiatric Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 135.1 - 160.2.

2. By virtue of the Podiatric Medical Practice Act, the Board has the power and jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of the Podiatric Medical Practice Act to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

The defendant's conduct above constitutes a violation of the Podiatric Medical Practice Act.

**ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE THE ORDER OF THE BOARD that the defendant's license to practice podiatric medicine in the State of Oklahoma be placed on a one-year probation with terms to include periodic audits of his practice.
