ORDER OF CONTINUANCE AND SUSPENSION OF LICENSE

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on June 8, 1990, at the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Stefan Kostiuk, M.D., Defendant, did not appear either in person or by representative.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc reviewed exhibits, and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. That Defendant, Stefan Kostiuk, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 13231.
- 2. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. That on or around May 2, 1990, Complaint and Citation were issued against the Defendant. Said pleadings were served on the Defendant by certified mail on May 8, 1990, as reflected by the return receipt from the U.S. Post Office.
- 4. Defendant's only response was a handwritten letter to the Board Secretary dated May 23, 1990.
- 5. That the Defendant by the aforesaid letter requested postponement of hearing on the Complaint and Citation scheduled for June 8, 1990.
- 6. Suspension of license until further order will ensure that Defendant shall not practice without submitting evidence of successful completion of in-patient rehabilitation to the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That a continuance of the case is within the judgment and discretion of the Board in the handling of its docket under the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1989, Sec. 481 et seq.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- That hearing on the Complaint and Citation involving Defendant, Stefan Kostiuk, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 13231, should be and the same is hereby CONTINUED and postponed from June 8, 1990, to whenever Dafendant completes in-patient treatment and makes application or motion with the Board to reset the aforesaid hearing.
- It is further ordered that Defendant's Oklahoma Medical License No. 13231 should be and is hereby SUSPENDED until successful completion of in-patient treatment as demonstrated to the Board.
- That the Board specifically makes no final findings or determinations on any of the allegations of the Complaint and reserves judgment thereon.
- That a copy of this Order be forwarded to the Defendant at the most recent address he has provided the Board staff.
