ORDER MODIFYING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on November 4, 2004, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Lori Hansen, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 13287, appeared in person without counsel, thereby waiving her right to legal representation.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 2. Dr. Hansen currently holds medical license no. 13287 under a five-year term of probation that commenced July 18, 2002.
- 3. On November 4, 2004, Dr. Hansen requested that the terms of her probation be modified to allow her to reapply for her state and federal controlled dangerous drug permits, and that she be allowed to write prescriptions for controlled dangerous drugs in Schedules III, IV and V on duplicate, serially numbered prescriptions.
 - 4. Dr. Hansen presented sufficient evidence to support the requested modification.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 et seq.
- 2. Dr. Hansen has presented satisfactory evidence to justify allowing her to reapply for her state and federal controlled dangerous drug permits, and to write prescriptions for controlled dangerous drugs in Schedules III, IV and V on duplicate, serially numbered prescriptions.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1 Dr. Hansen's application to modify the terms of her probation is **GRANTED**.
- 2. Dr. Hansen's probation shall continue for five (5) years from the date of its commencement of July 18, 2002 under the terms and conditions set forth in the July 18, 2002 Order, with the exception that Dr. Hansen be allowed to reapply for her state and federal controlled dangerous drug permits, and to write prescriptions for controlled dangerous drugs in Schedules III, IV and V on duplicate, serially numbered prescriptions.
- 3. Failure to meet any of the terms of this Order will be grounds for the Board to initiate proceedings to suspend or revoke Dr. Hansen's medical license, after additional notice and hearing as required by law.
- 4. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Hansen as soon as it is processed.
