VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE
IN LIEU OF PROSECUTION

I, Lori Hansen, M.D., being of lawful age and after first being duly sworn, depose and state as follows:

1. I hereby voluntarily surrender my Oklahoma medical license no. 13287.
2. The surrender of my license is freely and voluntarily made. I have not been subject to any coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the consequences of the surrender of my license.
3. I am the subject of a Complaint before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision involving allegations that if proven, would constitute grounds for disciplinary action by the Board.
4. The allegations to which I have plead guilty are as follows:
 - A. Beginning in or around January 1997 and continuing through June 2000, Defendant obtained controlled dangerous substances by fraud for her own personal use by writing fraudulent prescriptions for Hydrocodone and stealing

samples of Hydrocodone from her office sample cabinet. Defendant was subsequently **SUSPENDED** by the Board on January 18, 2002 until she obtained an assessment and treatment for substance abuse at Talbott Recovery Center.

B. Defendant subsequently obtained the assessment and treatment for substance abuse and on July 18, 2002, the Board entered an Order Granting Reinstatement of License Under Terms of Probation beginning July 18, 2002, to be followed by a five (5) year term of **PROBATION**.

C. The Order Granting Reinstatement of License Under Terms of Probation sets forth Defendant's terms of probation and provides that Defendant shall be on probation as follows:

(J) Defendant will have the affirmative duty not to ingest any substance, including but not limited to alcohol, which will cause a body fluid sample to test positive for prohibited substances.

(L) Defendant will abide by the terms and recommendations of her postcare contracts with Talbott and the Physicians' Recovery Program...

(R) Defendant shall promptly notify the Board of any relapse, including any entry, or re-entry, into a treatment program for substance abuse.

D. The provisions cited above have not been modified or deleted but remain in full force and effect as terms and conditions of Defendant's probation.

E. On or about July 7, 2005, after attending two (2) support group meetings, Defendant drove to a liquor store, purchased some alcohol, and relapsed on the alcohol.

F. On July 8, 2005, Defendant was asked to provide a urine specimen to the Physicians' Recovery Program.

G. The following week, Defendant again relapsed on alcohol.

H. Defendant was subsequently notified by the Physicians' Recovery Program that she had tested positive for alcohol on the July 8, 2005 specimen.

I. Defendant did not immediately notify the Board of her two relapses, but waited until August 12, 2005 to notify Mr. Tom Sosbee, the Board Compliance and Education Coordinator, that she had relapsed over a month earlier.

J. On or about August 30, 2005, Defendant sought substance abuse treatment at the William J. Farley Center in Williamsburg, Virginia. While there, she admitted that she had self-medicated with alcohol and other drugs.

K. On or about Sept 30, 2005, Defendant left treatment against staff advice. At that time, she was advised to close her practice immediately and return to treatment. She was further advised that she should not be allowed to return to practice medicine until she successfully completed treatment at a long-term care facility.

L. At this time, Defendant has failed to obtain the treatment recommended by the Farley Center.

M. Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct in that she:

i. Habitually uses habit-forming drugs in violation 59 O.S. 407 §509(4) and OAC 435:10-7-4(3).

ii. Engaged in dishonorable or immoral conduct which is likely to deceive, defraud or harm the public in violation of 59 O.S. §509(8) and OAC 435:10-7-4(11).

iii. Violated any provision of the medical practice act or the rules and regulations of the Board or of an action, stipulation, or agreement of the Board in violation of 59 O.S. §509(13) and OAC 435:10-7-4(39).

iv. Is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of age, illness, drunkenness, excessive use of drugs, narcotics, chemicals or any other type of material or as a result of any mental or physician condition in violation of 59 O.S. §509(15) and OAC 435:10-7-4(40).

5. I hereby submit my wallet card and wall certificate as evidence of my intent to surrender my license.

6. I hereby agree that I will not apply for reinstatement of my Oklahoma medical license for a minimum of one year from the entry of the Order Accepting Voluntary Surrender in Lieu of Prosecution, and that if the Board ever reinstates my Oklahoma medical license, it will be under terms of probation to be set by the Board at the time of reinstatement.

7. As a condition to accepting my surrender of license in lieu of prosecution, I acknowledge that the Board may require me to pay all costs expended by the Board for any legal fees and costs, and any investigation, probation and monitoring fees, including but not limited to staff time, salary and travel expense, witness fees and attorney fees.
