ORDER TABLING LICENSURE REINSTATEMENT APPLICATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on July 19, 2007, at the office of the Board, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board. Applicant appeared in person and through counsel, Linda G. Scoggins. The State was represented by Assistant Attorney General, Elizabeth A. Scott.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the application and all attached exhibits, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Applicant applied for reinstatement of her license in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon.
- 2. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. The evidence reflects that the reinstatement application of LORI ELDEAN HANSEN was heard on July 19, 2007 before the Board *en banc*. Questions were raised regarding her prior discipline by the Board in 2002, her Voluntary Surrender of License in Lieu of Prosecution in March 2006, her incomplete treatment at the Farley Center in 2005, her relapse after treatment at Farley, and her failure to complete treatment at a long-term care facility as recommended by Farley. The Board requested that the application be tabled until the Applicant obtains an assessment at a nationally recognized treatment center acceptable to the Board and approved by the Board Secretary, after which time the Applicant may present her assessment report to the Board for further consideration on her request for reinstatement.

4. Applicant's request for licensure should be tabled without further consideration so as to allow the Applicant to submit the information requested by the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has legal authority to table an application when evidence on the application is insufficient to allow evaluation by the Board to make a final judgment as to whether the Applicant fulfills the requirements of 59 Okla. Stat. §481 *et seq.*, and the applicable rules of the Board to qualify for licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon.

ORDER

It is therefore **ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. The reinstatement application of LORI ELDEAN HANSEN for licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon should be **TABLED**.
- 2. The Board will make no further consideration on this application until Applicant obtains an assessment at a nationally recognized treatment center acceptable to the Board and approved by the Board Secretary, after which time the Applicant may present her assessment report to the Board for further consideration on her request for reinstatement.
- 3. A copy of this written order should be sent to the Applicant as soon as it is processed.
