

4. Applicant's request for licensure should be tabled without further consideration so as to allow the Applicant to submit the information requested by the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has legal authority to table an application when evidence on the application is insufficient to allow evaluation by the Board to make a final judgment as to whether the Applicant fulfills the requirements of 59 Okla. Stat. §481 *et seq.*, and the applicable rules of the Board to qualify for licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon.

ORDER


It is therefore **ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. The reinstatement application of LORI ELDEAN HANSEN for licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon should be **TABLED**.

2. The Board will make no further consideration on this application until Applicant obtains an assessment at a nationally recognized treatment center acceptable to the Board and approved by the Board Secretary, after which time the Applicant may present her assessment report to the Board for further consideration on her request for reinstatement.

3. A copy of this written order should be sent to the Applicant as soon as it is processed.


