**ORDER DENYING TERMINATION OF PROBATION**

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on July 22, 2010, at the Board's office, 101 N.E. 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Lori Hansen, M.D., appeared in person, *pro se*, thereby waiving her right to legal counsel at the hearing.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the exhibits presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

***Findings of Fact***

1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
2. Dr. Hansen currently holds medical license no. 13287 under an indefinite term of probation that commenced on September 20, 2007.
3. On July 22, 2010, Dr. Hansen requested that her probation be terminated so that she could join the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery.
4. The evidence reflects the following:
  - a. On January 18, 2002, Dr. Hansen's license was first suspended by the Board.

- b. On July 18, 2002, Dr. Hansen's license was reinstated and she was placed on a five (5) year probation.
- c. In July 2005, Dr. Hansen relapsed on alcohol.
- d. On March 9, 2006, Dr. Hansen voluntarily surrendered her license in lieu of prosecution.
- e. On September 20, 2007, the Board reinstated Dr. Hansen's license under indefinite probation.
- f. At the time of her request for termination of probation, Dr. Hansen had served less than three (3) years of her indefinite probation.

5. The proposed termination of Dr. Hansen's probation does not afford sufficient practice limitations or controls to assure that Dr. Hansen can practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear requests for termination of probations under 59 Okla. Stat. §480 *et seq.*
- 2. The Board may impose practice parameters and other restrictions as necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public under 59 Okla. Stat. §480 *et seq.*

#### **ORDER**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. Dr. Hansen's request for termination of her probation is **DENIED**.
- 2. A copy of this written order shall be sent to Dr. Hansen as soon as it is processed.
