



- a. On January 18, 2002, Dr. Hansen's license was first suspended by the Board.
- b. On July 18, 2002, Dr. Hansen's license was reinstated and she was placed on a five (5) year probation.
- c. In July 2005, Dr. Hansen relapsed on alcohol.
- d. On March 9, 2006, Dr. Hansen voluntarily surrendered her license in lieu of prosecution.
- e. On September 20, 2007, the Board reinstated Dr. Hansen's license under indefinite probation.
- f. At the time of this request for termination of probation, Dr. Hansen has served approximately four (4) years of her indefinite probation.

6. The proposed termination of Dr. Hansen's probation does not afford sufficient practice limitations or controls to assure that Dr. Hansen can practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety.

#### ***CONCLUSIONS OF LAW***

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear requests for termination of probations under 59 Okla. Stat. §480 *et seq.*
2. The Board may impose practice parameters and other restrictions as necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public under 59 Okla. Stat. §480 *et seq.*

#### ***ORDER***

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. Dr. Hansen's request for termination of her probation is **DENIED**.
2. A copy of this written order shall be sent to Dr. Hansen as soon as it is processed.
