ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc on February 3, 1990, at the office of the Oklahoma State Medical Association, 601 N.W. Expressway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Rodrigo I. Ramirez, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person, and by counsel, Howard Douglas Perkins, Jr.

The Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard testimony, reviewed exhibits tendered, and being fully advised in the premises the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision therefore finds and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Rodrigo I. Ramirez, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 13383.
2. That the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
3. That on or around February 25, 1988, Defendant was placed on probation to the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision for a period of five (5) years under certain enumerated terms and conditions. Since that time Defendant has been in compliance with the terms and conditions of probation.
4. That Defendant's practice of medicine and surgery does not pose any threat to public health, safety or welfare, and that probation previously imposed by the Board may be and should be terminated effective immediately.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the supervision of Defendant while under probation is within the statutory authority of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 59 O.S. Supp. 1989, Sec. 481 et seq.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the Defendant, Rodrigo I. Ramirez, M.D., Oklahoma Medical License No. 13383, should be and is hereby TERMINATED FROM PROBATION effective immediately.

2. That a copy of this Order should be mailed to the Defendant and a copy placed in the Defendant's file at the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.
