FINAL ORDER

This cause came on for consideration before the Secretary of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on the $//1/_$ day of $/2002/_$, 1987, at 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintff, and Gerald D. Chiss, Attorney, appeared for the Defendant.

The Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, by and through the Secretary, and being fully advised in the premises, therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Afifa G. Mina holds inactive Oklahoma Medical License No. 13601.

2. That the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

3. That Complaint and Citation were lawfully served on the Defendant in the month of July, 1987.

4. That in lieu of a formal hearing, the Defendant offers to immediately, voluntarily, and of her own volition surrender her Oklahoma medical license.

5. Defendant specifically does not admit as true and expressly denies any of the allegations pled in the Complaint that she comitted any unprofessional conduct in Oklahoma.

6. That, in lieu of a formal hearing, the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, by and through the Secretary, does agree to and does hereby accept the Defendant's voluntary surrender of license as a physician and surgeon in Oklahoma.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. That the Board, by and through the Secretary, has authority and discretion to accept voluntary surrender of a medical license in lieu of formal hearing regarding the above matters.
