ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This cause comes on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners en banc on September 5, 1986, at 5104 North Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff, and the Defendant, Frederick Charles Bibus, M.D., appeared in person without counsel and agreed to proceed, waiving his right to representation by legal counsel.

The Board of Medical Examiners en banc heard the testimony and reviewed the exhibits, and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Examiners therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Frederick Charles Bibus, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 13733.

2. That the Board of Medical Examiners en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

3. That the Defendant was heretofore placed on probation to the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners and that since that time the Defendant has been in compliance with all of the terms and conditions of the aforesaid probation.

4. That the purposes of the probation imposed by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners have been fulfilled and there does not exist any reason to continue this Defendant under probation to the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Board has continuing jurisdiction over this Defendant based on the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S.

1981, §507, and the prior individual proceeding which resulted in the original probation.


ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE Board of Medical Examiners of Oklahoma as follows:


1. That the probation heretofore imposed on Frederick Charles Bibus, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 13733, should be and the same is hereby terminated, cancelled and held for naught.

2. That the staff of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners should notify the Defendant of this decision as soon as possible and should note in the official record that the probation heretofore imposed on this Defendant has been lawfully terminated.


