That on or around August 22, 1985, the Defendant, while 2. being represented by counsel, Jack Winn, did voluntarily enter a plea of guilty in the District Court of Tulsa County to the charge of lewd molestation in Tulsa County Case No. CRF-85-1119 and that said charge is a felony and that the Defendant was sentenced to a term of six years to the custody of the State Department of Corrections with the further order that the Defendant serve two years of the sentence at the State Penitentiary at McAlester.

3. That the Clerk of the District Court of Tulsa County reports that said conviction has become final and that the court file does not reflect any appeal taken therefrom.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays this Board to conduct a hearing and upon proof of the allegations contained herein that such disciplinary action be taken by the Board as is authorized by law
