



3. Applicant applied for reinstatement of his Oklahoma medical license and on November 6, 2013 the Board denied Applicant's request for reinstatement.
4. The Applicant has again applied for reinstatement of his Oklahoma medical license.
5. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

**Conclusions of Law**


1. The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein pursuant to 59 O.S. §480 et seq.
2. The Applicant has failed to sustain his burden of proof that he has met all requirements for reinstatement of his medical license, including the requirement that he be of good moral character and competent to practice safely as required by 59 O.S. §495h.

**Order**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. Applicant's request for reinstatement of his medical license shall be **DENIED**.
2. A copy of this written order shall be sent to Applicant as soon as it is processed.
