FINAL ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSURE

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (the "Board") on September 157 (1995) at the offices of the Board, 5104 North Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

The applicant appeared in person with counsel, Robert Mitchell.

The Board en banc heard testimony, reviewed the application and all attached exhibits, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Applicant made application for reinstatement of licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon.
- 2. The Board en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. The evidence reflects that Applicant has been revoked and sober for less than two years.
- 4. These factors raise serious issues as to the Applicant's ability to practice medicine and surgery with reasonable skill and safety, and the Applicant has failed to produce evidence to overcome the issues as to his competency and fitness to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Oklahoma.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Applicant failed to fulfill the requirements of 59 O.S. § 481 et seq., and the applicable rules of the Board to qualify for licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon.

It is therefore ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. The application of Lynn Dean Baggett for reinstatement of licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon should be and the same hereby is DENIED.
- 2. A copy of this written Order shall be sent to the Applicant as soon as it is processed.
