## ORDER OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF OKLAHOMA MEDICAL LICENSE

This cause came on for emergency consideration by the undersigned Secretary of the State Board of Medical Examiners on the  $29^{11}$  day of 3000, 1987.

That upon reviewing the files and being fully advised in the premises, the Secretary of the State Board of Medical Examiners finds as follows:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. That C. Francis Roe, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 14622.
- 2. That the Board of Medical Examiners en banc, by and through the Secretary, has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice is not required by law or the rules of the Board
- 3. That a review of records indicates that both the Connecticut Medical Examining Board and the Medical Executive Committee of the Lawrence and Memorial Hospitals, New London, Connecticut, found the Defendant's professional treatment of some patients was incompetent and/or negligent, and that Defendant was unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety and his treatment was "deficient."
- 4. That a review of records indicates further that the Defendant on May 30, 1986, filed an Application for Renewal of Oklahoma Medical License and the Defendant did not truthfully answer the question thereon which asked, "Have you ever been the

subject | of disciplinary action by any Governmental or Licensing
Authority, Federal, State or Local?"

5. That these circumstances and facts are such that public health, safety or welfare imperatively requires emergency action on this date, pending a future show cause hearing at a prompt time.

#### CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. That Summary Suspension of a License is within the power of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners, acting by and through the Secretary, 59 O.S. 1981, Section 503, and 75 O.S. 1981, Section 314(c).

#### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Examiners of Oklahoma, by and through the Secretary, as follows:

- 1. That the Defendant's Oklahoma Medical License No. 14622 should be and is hereby suspended until further order of the Board.
- 2. That the Defendant may appear at a Show Cause Hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners en banc at 4:00 p.m., on SATWAY, the 11 day of July, 1987, in LAWTON, Oklahoma, at the following address: 3401 West Gore Blvd.
- 3. That a copy of this Order be personally served on the Defendant as soon as possible by personnel of the Investigative Division of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners.
