FINAL ORDER

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff, and George Paull, Jr., Attorney, appeared for the Defendant.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, by and through the Secretary, and being fully advised in the premises, therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. That C. Francis Roe, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 14622.
- 2. That the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by the law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. That Complaint and Citation were lawfully served on the Defendant on the 2^{kd} day of July, 1987.
- 4. That on that same day the Defendant was lawfully served with an Order of Summary Suspension of Oklahoma Medical License.
- 5. That in lieu of a formal hearing and pending some resolution of action taken by the Connecticut Medical Examining Board on February 17, 1987, and pending some resolution of actions at the Jackson County Memorial Hospital, Altus, Oklahoma, the Defendant offers to immediately, voluntarily, and of his own volition surrender his Oklahoma medical license.
- 6. Defendant specifically does not admit as true and expressly denies any of the allegations pled in the Complaint or that he committed any unprofessional conduct in Oklahoma.
- 7. That, in lieu of a formal hearing, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, by and through the Secretary, does agree to and does hereby accept the Defendant's voluntary surrender of license as a physician and surgeon in Oklahoma.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Tht the Board, by and through the Secretary, has authority and discretion to accept voluntary surrender of a medical license in lieu of formal hearing regarding the above matters.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision of Oklahoma as follows:

- That the Defendant's offer to voluntarily surrender his Oklahoma Medical License should be and is hereby accepted.
- That the Defendant will not practice medicine and surgery in Oklahoma pending re-application to and approval by this Board.
