WAIVER OF SERVICE AND  
VOLUNTARY SUBMITTAL TO JURISDICTION

COMES NOW the Defendant, Michael Britton Beason, M.D., the undersigned, and states that on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1986, he is of sound mind and not under the influence of any medication or drug or impaired therefrom, and said Defendant does further recognize his right to legal counsel and knowingly waives said right and of his own volition and decision waives his right to the issuance, service, and return of of process on him in this action as required by 59 O.S. 1981, §503, and the rules of the Board of Medical Examiners, and said Defendant does hereby voluntarily and of his own volition admit and plead that the facts alleged in the Complaint of Contempt served on him this date are true and correct and the Defendant does further voluntarily and of his own volition submit to the jurisdiction of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners insofar as it entails the following activities:

1. That the Defendant should be and does hereby agree to a period of probation to begin immediately and to run until the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners and the Defendant shall be under probation under the following terms and conditions:

(a) That during the period of probation it is required that Dr. Beason comply with the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act as interpreted by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners and that he appear before the Board or its designated representative upon request.

(b) That during the period of probation Dr. Beason will submit biological fluid specimens to include, but not limited to, blood and urine, for analysis at the expense of Dr.

Beason upon the request of any inspector or other agent representing the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners.

(c) During the period of probation Dr. Beason will take no scheduled drug or alcohol except that which is authorized by a physician treating him for a legitimate medical need and the Defendant has the specific responsibility of advising any treating physician of his complete medical history, including his use of the drugs Darvon, Vicodin, and Darvocet N-100.

(d) Dr. Beason will provide to any inspector or other agent representing the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners the name and office address of each physician treating him for legitimate medical need and Dr. Beason will sign a release for medical records whenever requested by any agent or inspector representing the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners.

(e) Dr. Beason will continue in private therapy and group therapy under the direction and treatment of drug and alcohol counselor Steve West.


(f) That Dr. Beason will comply with all of the plan of recovery set forth by Mr. West, which is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit A.

(g) Dr. Beason shall submit periodic progress reports from Mr. West as required by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners or any agent or inspector thereof.


2. The undersigned agrees and stipulates that the jurisdiction of the Board will continue in this matter until lifted by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners on their own motion or on the motion of the undersigned.

3. The undersigned further agrees that failure to meet any of the above requirements, or the presence of foreign substances in his bodily fluids, will constitute cause for the Board to initiate proceedings to suspend or revoke his medical license, after due notice and hearing.
