DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE
OF COMPLAINT OF CONTEMPT

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on October 27, 1990, at the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Michael B. Beason, M.D., Defendant, appeared by announcement.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard the oral argument of counsel, reviewed exhibits, and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Michael B. Beason, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 14702.
2. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
3. That since the filing and service of the Complaint of Contempt of Final Order based on Defendant's non-payment of costs of investigation, prosecution and probation, the Defendant did pay the aforesaid costs and purged himself of any contempt of the prior Board order.
4. That the aforesaid Complaint of Contempt of Final Order should be dismissed with prejudice.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1989, Sec. 481 et seq., and the Board has jurisdiction to dismiss said case upon the Defendant's purging himself of contempt.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the Complaint of Contempt of Final Order filed herein should be and the same is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
2. That Defendant should receive a copy of this order.
