COMES NOW the defendant, Paul Davis Johnson, M.D., and hereby voluntarily surrenders his license to practice medicine and surgery to the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (the "Board"). The defendant acknowledges that during the period of the surrender of his license, the defendant shall not in any capacity practice medicine and surgery in the State of Oklahoma. The defendant agrees that this surrender of license shall continue until the defendant presents to the Secretary of the Board satisfactory evidence that the defendant has fully and successfully completed a program of treatment for alcohol dependency approved by the Secretary and that the defendant has entered into a contract of after care for alcohol dependency approved by the Secretary. In the event the defendant fails to meet these conditions by November 1, 1994, this matter shall be set for hearing at the next meeting before the Board for disciplinary action. Failure to comply with the terms of this voluntary surrender shall constitute failure to comply with an Order of the Board and shall not preclude other

action currently pending before the Board.

Upon completion of the terms and conditions set forth above, and only thereupon, the defendant shall be eligible to enter into a voluntary submittal to jurisdiction with the Board to practice medicine and surgery in this state subject to terms of probation imposed by the Board. Eligibility shall be determined by the Secretary and not the defendant.
